



PRACTICAL CE STATIONS MEDICAL AND TRAUMA

Two rooms will be dedicated exclusively to practical stations that rotate every 30 minutes. The practical rooms will be available on Friday and Saturday and are open on a first-come, first-served basis, except for reservations. The first hour and a half of each morning and the first hour of each afternoon will only be for those with reservations. Reservations may be made on the EMS EXPO Registration Form for \$25 in addition to your EXPO registration fee. Following that the practical rooms will be open to everyone on a first-come first-served basis. The \$25.00 fee is non-refundable. Reservations will not be accepted after April 11, 2010.

Here's How it Works...

Volunteers will staff the waiting area of the practical rooms and will manage the flow of students in and out of the rooms. Once the rooms are full for the first session, waiting participants will be given a number for the room they are waiting to enter. As participants complete stations and leave the practical rooms,

waiting participants will be allowed to enter. Participants who are not present when their number is called will forfeit their place... NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

Once inside a practical room, participants will begin to rotate through practical scenario stations. Participants will receive an evaluation form at each station. These forms must be turned in when leaving the rooms in order to receive credit.

EACH STATION = 1/2 CREDIT

New: The practical stations will have a SimMan[®] (provided by Livingston County EMS) and an iStan[®] (provided by St. Joseph Mercy Health System). These are patient simulators with realistic anatomy and clinical functionality. They provide simulation-based education to challenge and test students' clinical and decision-making skills during realistic patient care scenarios. If you have never used one this is your opportunity.
